Organized an Expert Talk on

Ethics and Responsible Use of Artificial Intelligence

An Expert Talk on "Ethics and Responsible Use of Artificial Intelligence" was organized on 30 May 2026 by the Post Graduate Department of Computer Science & Applications in collaboration with the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Khalsa College, Sri Anandpur Sahib. The session was conducted for the teaching faculty of Dashmesh Public School, Gurplah Sahib, Una and Sahibzada Ajit Singh Public School, Ladhewal-Mahilpur with the objective of creating awareness about the ethical implications, responsible adoption and effective utilization of Artificial Intelligence in education.

The session was delivered by Prof. Tajinder Kaur, Assistant Professor, PG Department of Computer Science & Applications, Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Khalsa College, Sri Anandpur Sahib. During the expert talk, she introduced the participants to the fundamentals of Artificial Intelligence and its increasing impact on various sectors, particularly education. She discussed the opportunities and challenges associated with AI technologies and highlighted the importance of using AI tools in a responsible, ethical and transparent manner.

Prof. Tajinder Kaur elaborated on key ethical concerns related to Artificial Intelligence, including data privacy, algorithmic bias, misinformation, intellectual property rights, and academic integrity. She also demonstrated various AI-powered tools that can assist teachers in lesson planning, content generation, assessment, personalized learning and administrative tasks. The participants were encouraged to critically evaluate AI-generated content and maintain human oversight while integrating AI into educational practices.

Principal Dr. Jasvir Singh appreciated the initiative and emphasized that Artificial Intelligence is transforming the educational landscape at an unprecedented pace. He highlighted the importance of equipping educators with the knowledge and skills required to use AI responsibly.

Dr. Surender Kumar, Head, PG Department of Computer Science & Applications, encouraged the participants to remain updated with emerging technologies and explore innovative teaching methodologies supported by AI. He emphasized that awareness of ethical issues and responsible AI practices is essential for educators to guide students effectively in the digital era.

The session witnessed enthusiastic participation from 61 teachers representing both schools. The participants actively interacted during the session, sharing their perspectives and raising questions regarding the practical implementation of AI tools in teaching and learning environments.

The event concluded with a vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the resource person, participating schools and all attendees for their active participation and contribution to the success of the programme.

Objectives: To sensitize school teachers about the ethical, responsible, and effective use of Artificial Intelligence and its applications in modern education.

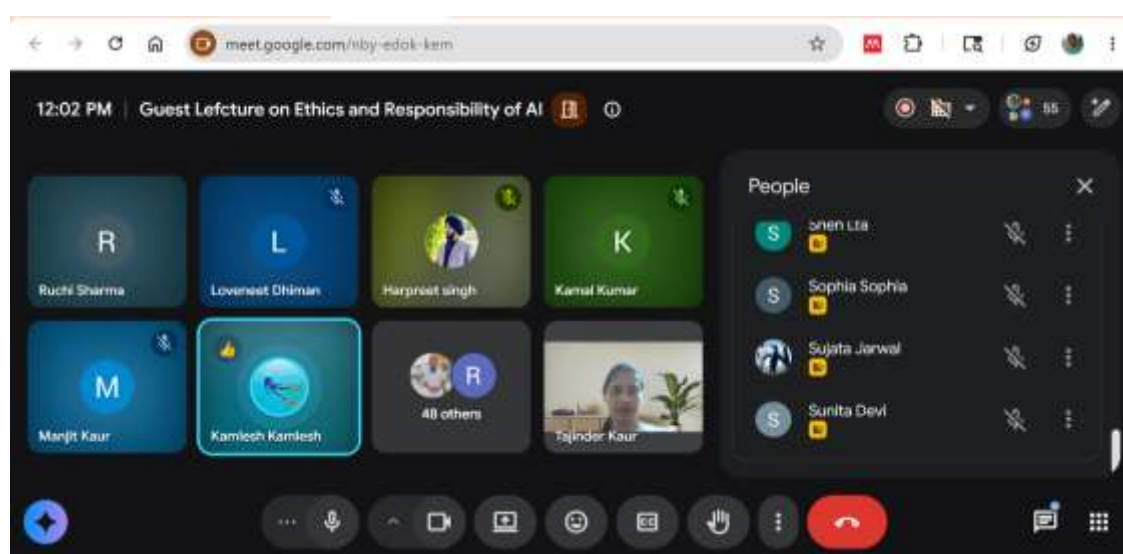
