- Abstract should be submitted as MS-Word Document. The font should be Times New Roman (12 size), page spacing 1.5.
- Upon acceptance of the abstract full paper must be submitted.
- Full paper length should not exceed more than 3000 words.
- Paper should include author's name(s), affiliation, corresponding email Id(s), contact number with proper references (MLA 9th Edition).
- Accepted abstracts will be given 05 minutes time for presentation and 2 minutes time for question and answers session.
- In case of more than one author, each has to register separately.
