The session aimed to explore how Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) can be integrated into the vision of NEP 2020 to promote holistic, values-based, and culturally rooted education.

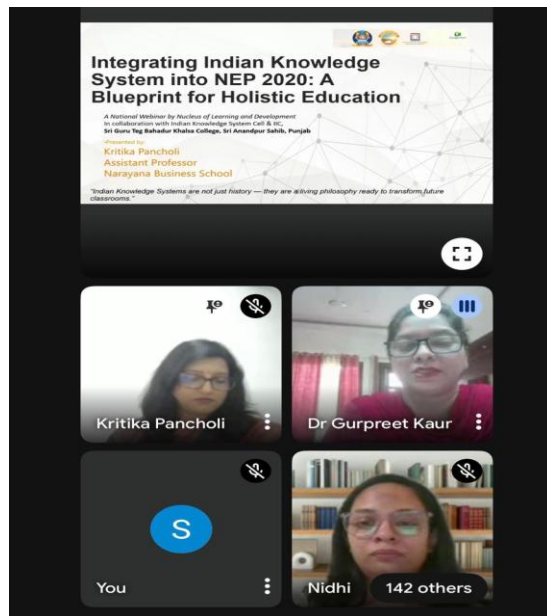


Image1: Dr. Gurpreet Kaur, President, IIC & I/C, IKS cell, welcoming the guest speaker and all participants during the National webinar.

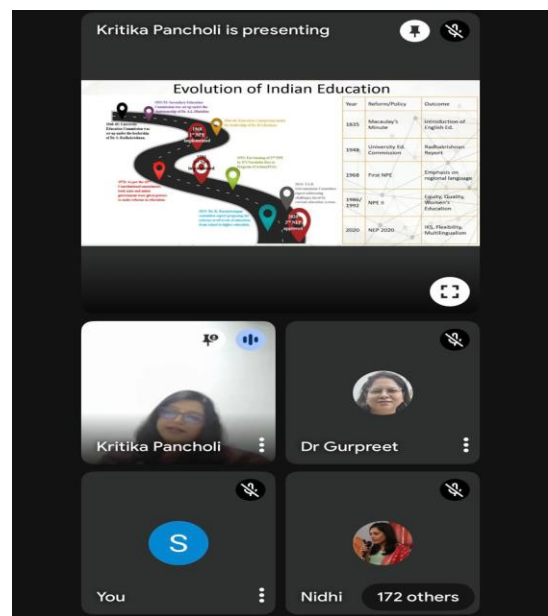
