



**One-Week National Faculty Development Program on  
“Teaching with Chatbots: Reimagining Pedagogy in the AI Era” from 5 to 11 Feb, 2026**

The Institution’s Innovation Council (IIC) and R&D Cell of Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Khalsa College, Sri Anandpur Sahib, Punjab, in collaboration with Nucleus of Learning and Development, successfully organized a National One-Week Faculty Development Program (FDP) titled “Teaching with Chatbots: Reimagining Pedagogy in the AI Era” from 5th February to 11th February 2026 in online mode enabling participation from academicians, researchers, and learners across the country.

The program was organized under the guidance of Dr. Jasvir Singh, Principal, who served as the Convener. The FDP was coordinated by Dr. Gurpreet Kaur, President–IIC, and co-coordinated by Prof. Tajinder Kaur and Prof. Payal from the Department of Computer Science. These hands-on demonstrations enabled participants to understand not only the technical capabilities of AI tools but also their pedagogical significance in modern classrooms.

Participants appreciated the relevance of the topic, the clarity of the sessions and the practical exposure to AI tools for teaching and research purposes.
