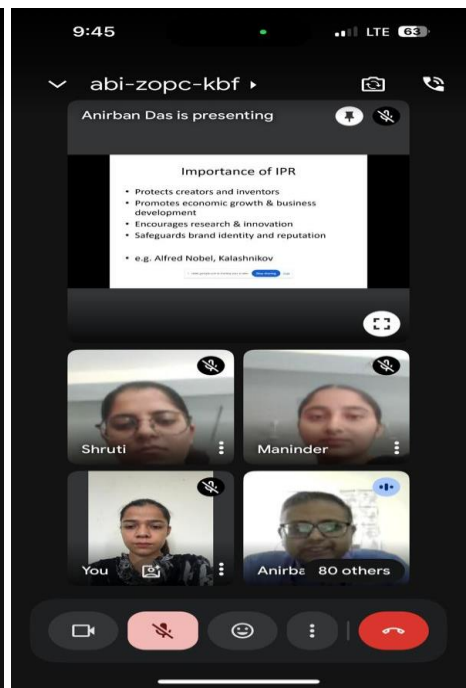
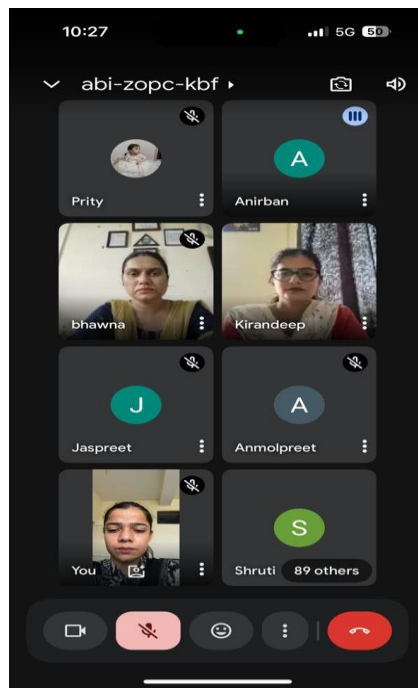
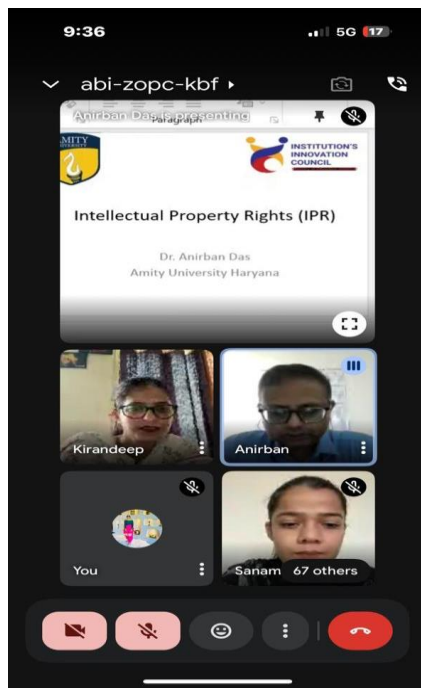
The lecture was highly interactive, and students actively participated by asking questions about patent filing, copyright protection, and startup-related IPR challenges.
