Visit to RS Farm, Bahadurpur
Department of Agriculture

The Department of Agriculture, Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Khalsa College, Sri Anandpur Sahib, in collaboration with the Institution's Innovation Council & Agrarian Society under the signed MOU, organized an educational visit to RS Farm, Bahadurpur on 3rd September, 2026 for the students of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture & B.Voc. Food Processing.

The main objective of the visit was to provide students with practical knowledge and real-life exposure to livestock farming, particularly cattle management. During the visit, farm owner Mr. Gagandeep Singh shared valuable insights and domain knowledge with the students regarding his farm operations and livestock management practices. Additionally, Dr. Rahulpreet Singh, (Animal Nutritionist) imparted valuable information and expertise to the students on livestock care and feed management.

The visit aimed to enhance students' understanding of scientific dairy farming practices, including feeding management, breeding techniques, housing systems, and health care of cattle. Students were also introduced to modern livestock management practices such as clean milk production, proper sanitation, waste management, and the use of farm by-products. Special emphasis was laid on the importance of animal nutrition, disease prevention, and maintaining hygienic conditions in dairy farms. The visit also created awareness about the role of livestock farming in sustainable agriculture and rural livelihoods.
