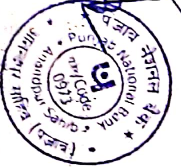

HUMAN RIGHTS (RIGHTS OF WOMEN)

Report

On 14 February, 2023 Post Graduate Department, English, Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Khalsa College, Sri Anandpur Sahib organised a National Human Rights Commission sponsored **One Day Training Programme on Rights of Women**. The objective of this programme was to make women aware of their rights to live free from violence and discrimination; to enjoy the highest attainable standards of physical and mental health; to be educated; to own property; to vote; and to earn an equal wage. Women's rights are very important for everyone all over the world. It does not just benefit her but every member of society. When women get equal rights, the world can progress together with everyone playing an essential role.

If there weren't any women rights, women wouldn't have been allowed to do something as basic as to vote. Further, it is a game-changer for those women who suffer from gender discrimination. Women rights are important as it gives women the opportunity to get an education and earn in life. It makes them independent which is essential for every woman on earth. Thus, we must all make sure women rights are implemented everywhere.

This programme was funded by National Human Rights, New Delhi. Deputy Commissioner of Ropar District Dr. Preeti Yadav was chief guest in this programme. Pam Rajput, Professor Emeritus, Punjab University, Chandigarh, Dr. Arti Puri, Professor, University Institute of Laws, Ludhiana, Dr. Monica Ahuja, Professor, Department of Law, Punjabi University, Patiala and Dr. Manju Verma, Former Director, Women Study Center, Punjabi University, Patiala chaired as resource persons.

The training programme was inaugurated by worthy Principal, Dr. Jasvir Singh. He introduced the theme of the event to the guests and talked about the meaning and necessity of women's rights and women empowerment. He also shed light on how by educating women we can bring equality in society.

Dr. Gurpreet Kaur, Head, P.G. Department of English, further elaborated on how education for women make them independent and confident which will further lead to the development of the nation. She informed the guests about the importance of the programme, its purpose of bringing awareness among people.

First session of the programme was conducted by Pam Rajput, which started at 10A.M. and it went on for one and half hour. She spoke about the basic rights of women, how women are emotionally stronger than man. However, women have not been treated nicely by men all throughout time. They have been denied their rights, their opportunities. She made people aware of the fundamental rights of women and legal rights that are provided to them by the constitution of our country. After that she also welcomed questions from the guests and answered with patience.

The second session was conducted by Dr. Monica Ahuja which started at 11:30 am clock and similarly went on for one and half hour. She spoke about human rights and the meaning of

constitution, the basic laws and rules of our country which provides equal socio economic rights to every individual. And how women have equal rights to the property of their parents. She re-introduced the basic commandments pertaining to human rights. She also accosted the guests regarding the issue of dowry that is still prevalent in rural areas. After that she introduced and made people aware of the new changes towards the rights of women that have been made.

Third session was conducted by Professor Arti Puri. She shared her views about Punjab Human Rights Commission and the equal rights provided to men and women. She hailed constitution as an empowering document. Then she talked about the opportunities given to women in this era and the issues women still are facing like domestic violence. To further elaborate on this, she talked about real life cases like how the air hostesses are treated even in this age. She made a point that the ground reality is different from how it is portrayed. Women are still facing many kinds of harassments such as mental and sexual; especially at work places women are facing many kinds of maltreatments.

The fourth session was conducted by Dr. Manju Verma. She introduced and analysed various social topics such as the need for the removal of three P's i.e. Power, Politics and Patriarchy from the system. Women hold the virtues like Knowledge, Awareness, Sensitivity, tolerance, patience and many more that makes them more powerful and deserving of being in the power. She then expounded on how students can do self-analysis with the help of SWOT that stands for Strength, Weakness, Opportunities and Threats. She then put emphasis on the importance of parenting for the growth of children. She also encouraged the students to be prepared for their future and to be smart about it.

Around 150 students and faculty of the host institute, students and teachers from nearby schools participated in this programme.

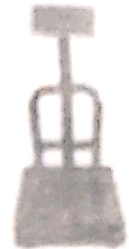

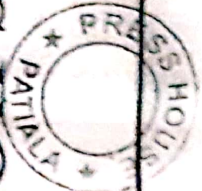
