Department of Agriculture

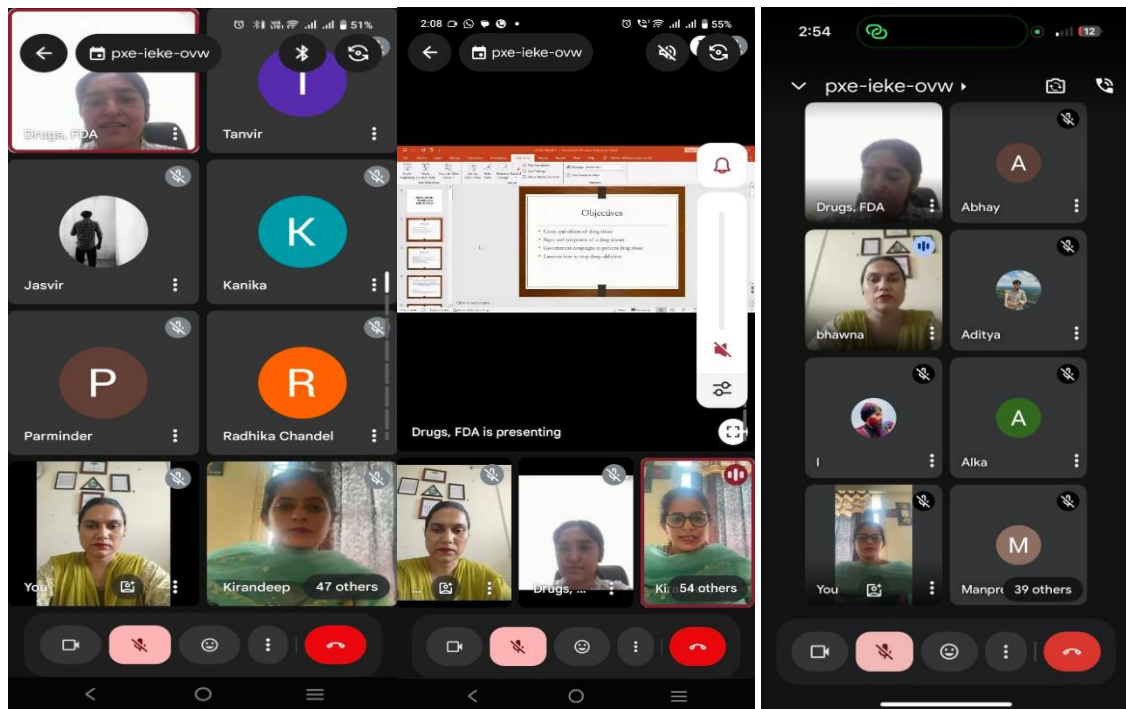
