
# Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Khalsa College, Sri Anandpur Sahib (An Autonomous College) Syllabus Feedback Report

#### A) Student Feedback



#### 1) Parameter: Course Content




## 2) Parameter: Extent of Course Objective Achieved






# 3) Learning Value (in terms of Knowledge, Concepts, Manual and Analytical Skills and Broadening Perspective)

Count of Parameter [Learning value (in terms of knowledge, concepts, manual& analytical skills and broadening




# 4) Parameter: Clarity and Relevance of Syllabus

Count of Parameter [Clarity and relevance of syllabus]




# 5) Relevance of Additional Source Material (Library, e-Resources and Journals)

Count of Parameter [Relevance of additional source material (Library, e-recourses & Journals)]




# 6) Availability and Utility of Reading/Reference Material
